Minutes of February 21st, 2011

Government Announcements:

There were actually no government announcements at the February meeting.

Public Comments:

Lucy said that the homeless use bus stops for shelter.

Ron, from the Griffith Park Neighborhood Council announced a councilman election forum at Marshall High School.

Roy Stone, from the Fairfax Library, spoke up in support of Measure L, the library measure on the March 8th ballot.

Hovik Zarakian spoke of a memorial Park at Garfield Park.

A supporter of Stephen Box spoke in support of Garfield Park.

Erik Sanjurjo mentioned that Fire Station 82, then a Whole Foods Market, then a market rate mixed use project, and now a senior housing facility were proposed for the site. He said the senior condo project is basically a “done deal.”

Jerry Hans, of Friends of Griffith Park, gave a presentation and update on the group. He also spoke about “PROS”, the open space committee, and that they may take HUNC up on an offer to furnish a meeting location for the committee.

Nathan French spoke again about community walks. The large tree was removed in the pocket park, and the church was in process of moving forward with plans after the person with Caltrans, their connection, fell ill.

Nathan also announced a councilman candidate forum would be held at the Seventh Day Adventist church on Thursday, February 24th. Erik Sanjurjo spoke mentioned about the great association we have with the church and about their being our community center.

Nathan also discussed "Just Food" part of Just Hollywood where organic food will be grown in a community garden and offered to be grown by high school students.

Treasurer's Report:

There was no treasurer's report due to Charles Suhayda's absence. Erik Sanjurjo mentioned that we need to spend or lose money. The only allocation so far has been \$1,200.00 for the newsletter.
