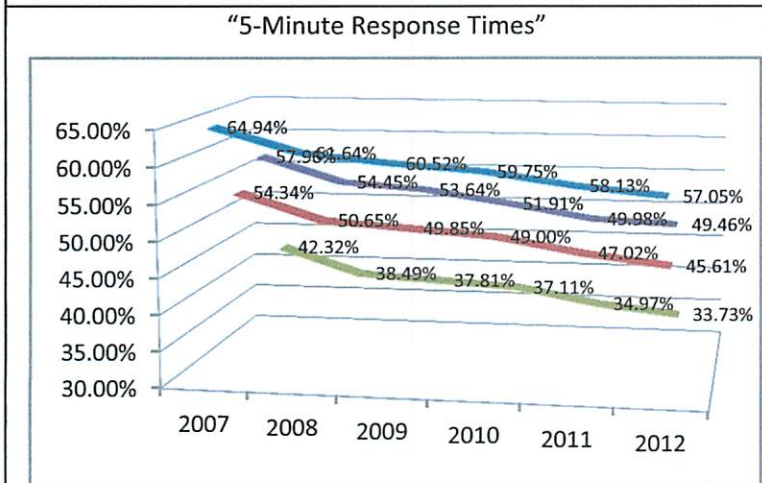
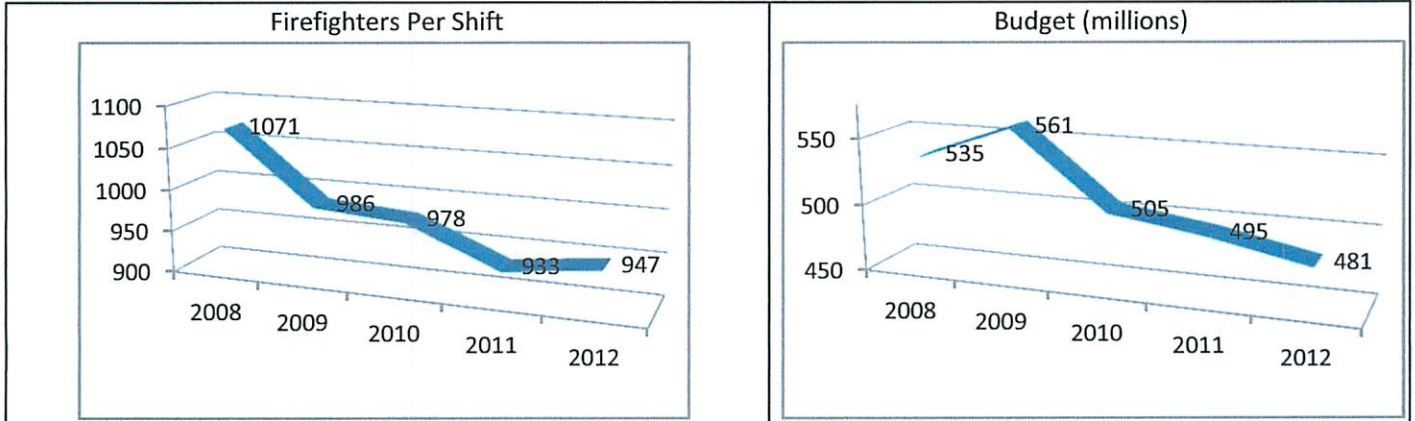
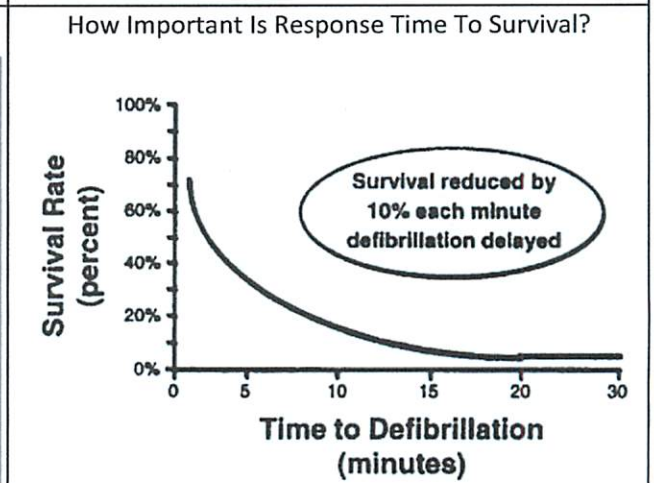


Key Call Types	LAFD Staffing	LAFD receives 3000 calls per day which result in 1300 incidents. 80% are EMS and 20% Fire. Fires require far more manhours per incident. Time assigned to EMS and Fire are about equal.
EMS: Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo with Alpha the least severe	Firefighters (Sworn) 3459	
Fire: Structure, Rubbish, Brush	Admin/Non-Sworn 296	
Others: Auto and HazMat	Per Shift 940	

How Does Budget Impact Response Time?



The "5-minute" clock ends when the "On Scene" button is pressed. Firefighters press that button between 10 and 60 seconds before they actually arrive. This chart shows response times no early press, 10, 30, and 60 second early presses. Actual response% is between 33.7% and 49.46%.
