On behalf of the LA City Attorney's Office, LA County District 3, LA City Council Districts 4 and 13, The Salvation Army, and the Greater West Hollywood Food Coalition - I thank you for your time, service, and support.

Here is a breakdown of the attendees and the services they utilized on Wednesday:

Number of event attendees:

71 individuals volunteered at the event\*

28 agencies provided direct services and referrals

289 participants attended the event to access services

\*Many of these volunteers also accessed services. They are not reflected in the 289 figure.

Type and frequency of services accessed:

74 individuals enrolled in the LA County Homeless Court Citation Clinic

92 individuals met with 211 for referrals to services

91 individuals got Hepatitis A vaccines

26 individuals got DMV IDs

12 individuals participated in art therapy with the Painted Brain

17 individuals got information from the LA County Child Support Services Department

30 individuals met with the Greater West Hollywood Food Coalition

3 individuals met with Youth Build Charter High School

29 individuals met with The Salvation Army for services

34 individuals accessed information from HACLA about Section 8

32 individuals got referrals for the Saban Community Clinic

16 individuals visited the Youth Policy Institute

13 individuals got tested for HIV/STIs at the JWCH Institute, Inc. Mobile Van

53 individuals met with the Department of Public Social Services

30 individuals met with the Los Angeles County Public Defender

16 individuals got haircuts with Svelte Barbershop + Essentials

24 individuals took showers at Lava Mae

300 individuals got meals from the LOCOL food truck courtesy of the Los Feliz Neighborhood Council

Hundreds of individuals got breakfast and bus tokens courtesy of the Hollywood and Sunset & Vine BIDs

325 hygiene kits were distributed by the Punk Rock Marthas and the Hollywood United Neighborhood Council

1000 pieces of clothing were distributed by Lyn Luzwick
